



Dear Sir,

With reference to the planning application UTT/21/2509/OP.

I am totally against this plan to build 230 plus houses on the above site on agricultural land because:

- 1)The proposed entrance to the site on a hill would exacerbate the danger on this narrow and winding road.
- 2)The many recent housing developments to the east of Saffron Walden and Swards End have contributed to a great increase of traffic both through Swards End and Saffron Walden. The main routes to schools and places of work need to pass through the already clogged streets in Saffron Walden contributing to pollution.
- 3)Children are having to travel out of the town to access school places as no extra schools are planned, in fact, a proposed new school was abandoned.
- 4)It is already very difficult for people to get dentists' and doctors' appointments as surgeries are already full.

Nothing has been mentioned about water supply or Sewage treatment, the water pressure in Swards End is poor and is the capacity for sewage treatment in Saffron Walden adequate to cope with the many new housing developments already built?

The character of the small community in Swards End, also the town of Saffron Walden will be spoilt by this further huge housing development.
